TBA Classes - Exhibitors may add a class to the show from the listed TBA classes with the payment of \$30.00 per day with their entries. TBA classes may be added and they will be added on a first come, first serve basis from the list of potential TBA classes. **The TBA fee does not include entry fees.**

Entries will be accepted no later than the end of the prior session.

The main ring is an Outdoor Covered Arena 274 'x 130', sand based with white vinyl fencing. The make up covered arena is 72' x 130' sand based and there is an additional outdoor arena 110' x 85'.

Prize checks will be mailed within 30 days of the show.

There will be only one owner per entry blank. Every Exhibitor or his/her agent or Trainer must sign the entry blank. All fees must accompany entry. Improperly completed entry forms will be returned to the Exhibitor. No entries will be accepted unless payment in full for fees is included. Upon entering additional classes, all fees must be paid at that time, if specific arrangements aren't made with the show office.

OVERALL HIGH POINT AMATEUR AWARD

This award will be presented to the amateur competitor who accumulates the greatest number of points in classes at the *Summer Sizzler I & II*. Points may be earned in any approved halter class (except futurities) or performance class in which entries are placed. Points are based on a one horse/one rider combination. Any Amateur may sign up as many one horse/one rider combinations as he/she wishes and may ride/handle horses which he/she does not own (in classes other than amateur-owner classes). Any amateur who wishes to compete for this award must sign up in the show office to participate in this high point program. Points do not start to accumulate until participant signs up. Points will be awarded as follows: first=5, second=4, third=3, fourth=2 and fifth=1. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the amateur who accumulates the highest number of points in the smallest number of classes. In the event of a further tie, the award will go to the rider who showed against the largest number of entries.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Photostat copies of your Amateur Certification, USEF Membership Card, AHA Membership Card and registration papers (both sides) for each horse entered **MUST** accompany your entries. Copy of Negative Coggins (6 months) and Health Certificate (30 days) are required for all out-of-state horses.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Show management will be charged with the responsibility of enforcing all USEF and AHA Rules. Special emphasis will be placed on the rules pertaining to the retention of natural action; expressly hoof length, weighted shoes or action appliances. The use of chains, rollers, or similar devices on the show grounds during or before a show are prohibited and the Show Committee shall bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the show, and they shall forfeit all entry fees and winnings for the entire show. USEF Rule XVI, Chapter I, Article 1601 regarding use of pads and bar shoes will be strictly enforced.

Show Management retains the right to request measurement of hoofs and inspection of pads of any or all horses in any or all classes.

OVAHA and/or Clark County Fairgrounds accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to any property or equipment, or for any damages to any animal, spectators or exhibitors at this competition.

Dress: It is the tradition of the show ring that riders and drivers be correctly attired for the class in question, THAT ATTENDANTS BE NEATLY DRESSED, and horse properly presented. The Show Committee will bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

Cancellation of Classes: The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes or make any scheduling for the betterment of the show.

Protests: A protest may be made to Show Committee by an exhibitor, an agent, trainer, or the parent of a Junior Exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the Secretary of the Show at which the violation occurred accompanied by a deposit of \$200 for a member (or parent of junior member) and \$300 for a non-member and received by a member of the Show Committee, the Show Manager or the Show Secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation. This deposit is fully refundable if the protest is upheld.

Disqualifications: If any Exhibitor has made any false statements regarding an animal exhibited, or if any Exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from exhibiting. Any action, discourtesy or disobedience to the official on the part of the owner, rider, exhibitor, groom or driver will disqualify the horse from being judged. The Show Management reserves the right to remove any of the previously mentioned (owner, rider, etc.) without being liable to compensation or damages.

Attention Handler: Cruelty to or the abuse of a horse by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of the whip on any horse in stall, runway, schooling area, show ring, or elsewhere on the show grounds before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty.

Stallions: Stallions may be shown by women and children in all classes except Lead Line and Walk-Trot.

Junior Exhibitors: Junior Exhibitor classes are limited to riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2008.

Amateur Classes: Every person who has reached his 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current amateur certification issued by USEF. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the Show Secretary at least one hour prior to such class an application for such certification provided by USEF. In the event that a person holds an unrevoked certification, but does not have it in his immediate possession, the Show Secretary may accept a signed statement to that effect which must be submitted to the USEF.

Limit Horse: This is a horse that has not won six, 1st place ribbons at USEF Regular Member (A, B, and C rated) Competitions. The status of Limit is as of the closing date of entries for any particular recognized competition.

Calls for Classes: When the start of any class with no posted order is being delayed by horses not ready to perform, the competition may be closed at the order of the Judge or Show Committee, provided warning is issued and exhibitors are given 3 minutes in which to appear at the in-gate ready to participate. In classes in which horses compete collectively, after warning is issued the In-gate must be closed 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring.

Parking: Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse trailers and campers. By Order of the State Fire Marshall, there is no parking in front of or between the barns.

Admission to Ring: No persons will be allowed in the ring except participants in class, judge, ringmaster, assistants and show photographer. Attendants will be allowed only after being called by the Judge or Ringmaster.

Stalling: All stalls will be reserved as paid for – NO STALL RESERVATIONS WITHOUT PAYMENT. Stalling is in permanent stalls 8 x 10 made from wood and wire fencing with wood sliding doors. Horses may be shown out of trailers. **NO BEDDING IS PROVIDED! Bedding will be available on show grounds.** No nails, staples, or other devices permitted in the permanent stalls. All stalls will be checked for damages and the exhibitor will be charged for such damage to stall(s).

Refunds: Refunds on all fees, except for stalls and office fees, will be made upon request with a written statement from your veterinarian if received by July 10, 2009. **No refunds will be made for any reason after July 10, 2009.**

Food: Food will be available on the grounds.

Showers: Showers are available on the grounds.

Camper Hook-ups: Camper hook-ups are available on a first come, first serve basis. Hook-up permits must be displayed in front window of vehicle at all times. The camper fees are paid to the Champion Center.

Motorized Vehicles: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

AHA Membership: Any owner without a current Competition Level AHA Membership must purchase a Single Event Membership for \$30 per person (not per horse). Also, Single Event Membership's are required of all owners, trainers, drivers, riders or halter handlers who do not have current Competition Level Membership.

Amateur Status: All riders in ATR classes must have an Amateur Card if over the age of 18. Riders must present this card or make application for one before entering the ring. Applications for amateur cards will be available in the Show Office.

In the event of illness or failure of a Show Official to attend this show or perform their duties, the Show Management reserves the right to substitute a Show Official.

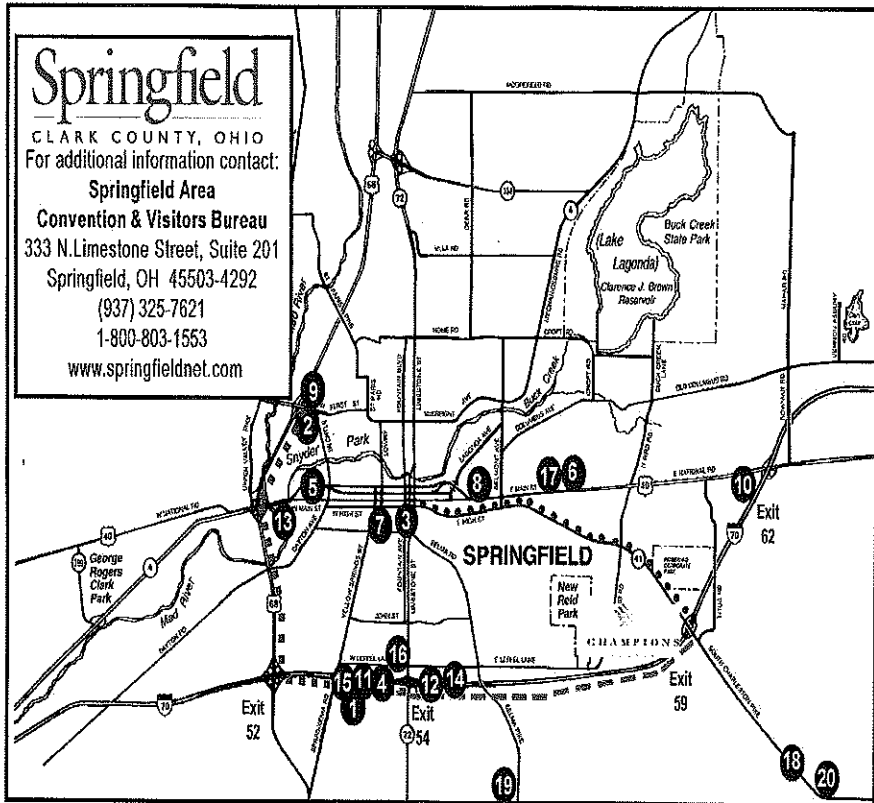

AHA MEDAL CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

AHA HUNT SEAT MEDAL NOT TO JUMP 17 & UNDER CLASS

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1.
2. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9.
3. For an AHA medal to be awarded, three (3) competitors with proper attachments must compete.

AHA SADDLE SEAT MEDAL CLASS 17 & UNDER CLASS

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1.
2. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Article 2219, Tests 1-15 or CEF equivalent. Markers shall not be used.
3. To fill a class three competitors with proper appointments must compete.

AHA REINING SEAT MEDAL 17 7 UNDER CLASS

1. All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining or EC equivalent. (Res 25-06)
2. Dropping of bits is optional with the Judge but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
3. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
4. In an AHA Reining Seat Medal class an off pattern rider is eliminated and is not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.
5. The prescribed AHA Reining Seat Equitation Score Sheet must be used posted in accordance with USEF rule AR199.5. (Res. 25-06)
6. Numbers must be worn on the rider's back or in the case of reining seat equitation on the left side of the saddle pad and must be clearly visible at all times when in competition. See USEF Rule EQ103.6. (Res. 8/07)

AHA HUNT SEAT NOT TO JUMP MEDAL CLASS

1. Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9

WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP

AR218 General

1. Following the rail work, all contestants are

- required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF AR222. (BOD 5/06)
2. Emphasis shall be placed on horse and rider working together on both rail and pattern work. Execution and correct form of both horse and rider, while maintaining a pleasurable ride are the main criteria for this class.
3. Judging is based 50% on rail work and 50% on pattern work.
4. Western Horsemanship is considered to be an Equitation class, therefore AR214 applies to these classes.

AR221 Class Conduct

1. Class routine will conform with EQ123, with the following exceptions: All exhibitors must be required to perform a pattern composed of a minimum of four tests from AF222; off pattern does not eliminate an exhibitor. Additional tests from AF222 may be requested by the judge to be performed either collectively or individually.
2. Instructions must be publicly announced and patterns must be posted at least one hour before the class.

AR222 Tests from which judges must choose:

1. Back
2. Individual performance on rail
3. Figure eight at the jog
4. Lope and stop
5. Group performance on rail
6. Figure eight at lope on the correct lead demonstrating simple change of lead
7. Serpentine at the jog
8. Ride without stirrups
9. Serpentine at the lope, with simple lead Changes
10. Change leads down the center of the ring or on rail demonstrating a simple change of lead. (In a simple change of lead, the horse if brought back to the halt and restarted into the lope on the opposite lead from the halt or walk.)
11. Execute quarter, half or full turn on the haunches turning either direction or both. Spins will be grounds for elimination (A spin is characterized by deep haunch flexion and both front legs off the ground at the same time during turn.)

Simply enroll your horse before the first date of competition for \$100 to start accumulating points to be paid back at the end of the competition year.

How points will be paid out.

HA recognized Shows and Events will receive 55% of the total collected funds will be paid. Total points earned each year in designated sweepstakes Classes and rides will be divided into the 55% to determine dollar value per point. AHA will issue a check to the recorded owner of the horse (as of December 31 of the competition year) based on show and ride results for that year.

Sweepstakes Point Program

This is an optional program when all Sweepstakes requirements are met. Sweepstakes Nominated Horses must be enrolled in the Points program in order to be eligible for prize money payout. Enrollments must be made on-line or postmark/electronic transaction dated to the HA office before the first day of the event. Event management may not accept Sweepstakes Point Program Enrollments.

1. Allocated and Points Payback Prize Money is available at each 2009 Regional Championship Horse Show.
2. When all Sweepstakes requirements are met, horses are automatically eligible to receive Allocated Prize Money in designated Regional and National Sweepstakes Classes.
3. Enrollment in Sweepstakes does not qualify a horse for Regional or National competition. Horses, except those in Yearling classes, must qualify for the class in accordance with the rules in the current *AHA Handbook*, the *U.S. Equestrian Rule Book* or the *Rules of Equine Canada*.
4. Entries in the Yearling Sweepstakes halter classes must have been nominated as Breeding Entries.
Original Entries are not eligible to compete in the Yearling Sweepstakes Halter classes (except at the local level).
5. Regional Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian yearlings that have won a 1st place in a Sweepstakes Class in one Regional Show cannot compete in the same class in any other Regional Show.
6. Only horses enrolled as Original Entries, Breeding Entries, Gelding Entries or Yearling Entries are eligible to receive Sweepstakes prize money in designated Sweepstakes classes.
Payouts for 2009 will be divided into the following percentages:
 - a. Local Shows & Events = 53%
 1. Total number of points earned by enrolled Sweepstakes horses will be divided into the 53% payout to determine dollar value per point.

The Allocated Prize Money at National and Regional Shows will be Paid as follows:

- c. Top Ten = 50% to be divided by 8 places
- d. Top Five = 50% to be divided by 3 places

8. Prize Money at the National, Regional, Local Shows and designated events will be paid only to the party whose name appears on a horses' Certificate of Registration on December 31 of the year the prize money is earned.
9. Checks for prize money shall be mailed after December 31 of each year, not later than 60 days of receipt of complete results for that year.

10. Sweepstakes Point Program is optional. Sweepstakes Nominated horses must enroll in the Sweepstakes Point Program to be eligible for prize money payout for accumulated points in Sweepstakes designated classes at National, Regional and Local Shows and events. Enrollments must be made on-line or postmarked/electronic transaction dated to the AHA office before the first day of the show. Event secretaries may not accept Sweepstakes Point Program Enrollments.
