There will be only one owner per entry blank. Every Exhibitor or his/her agent or Trainer must sign the entry blank. All fees must accompany entry. Improperly completed entry forms will be returned to the Exhibitor. No entries will be accepted unless payment in full for fees is included. Upon entering additional classes, all fees must be paid at that time, if specific arrangements aren't made with the show office.

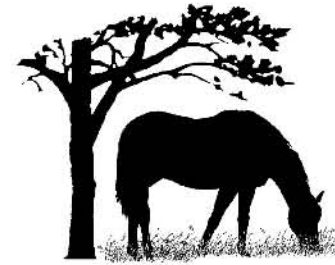

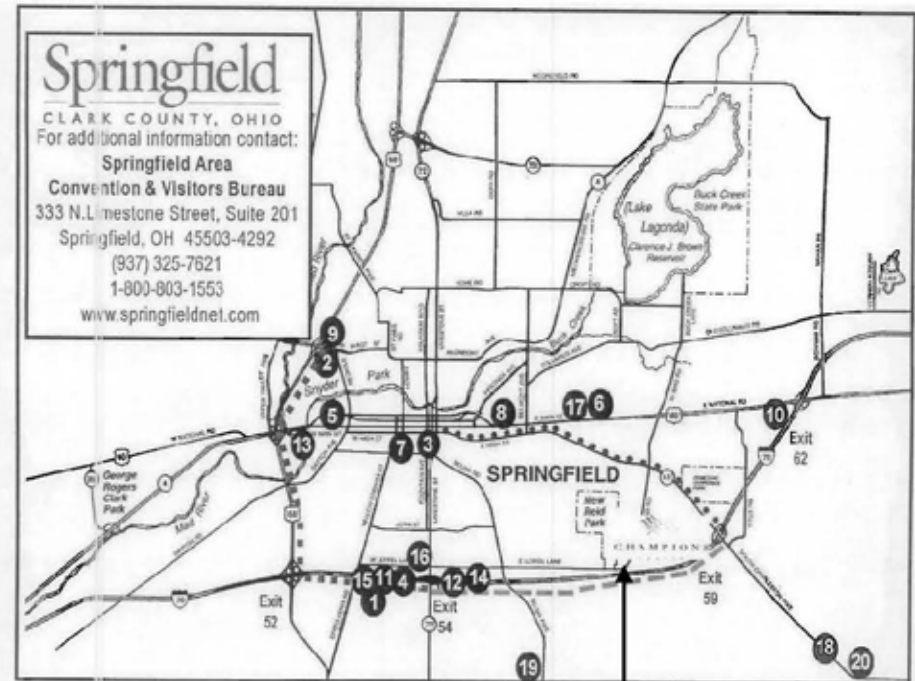

## 2011 AHA Medal Class Specifications

### AHA Hunter Seat Over Obstacles Medal class.

- To be shown over a course of not fewer than six obstacles with fence heights of 2'6" to 3' of which must include an oxer and two changes of direction (changes of lead).
- Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required from USEF Equitation Division EQ 113 - Tests 1 -7, 9-15, 17-19 (EC equivalent).

### AHA Saddle Seat Medal class.

- In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests (EQ 120) 1-15 (EC equivalent). Markers shall not be used. USEF Test 16 may only be called for at the National Shows.

### AHA Reining Seat Medal class.

- All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining Division (EC equivalent).
- Order of go will be done by draw.
- Bits must be dropped and inspected by the Judge or designated official, and all riders must dismount for this inspection. If called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.

- Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
- In the event the total score is tied, the tie will first be broken by the exhibitor with the highest equitation score. Should a tie still exist, the tie shall be broken by reining rules in RN 103.2.

- It is mandatory that judges use the prescribed AHA Score Seat for Reining Seat Equitation and that the score sheet or a copy be posted immediately after each class.

### AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal class.

- In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more tests from USEF Equitation Division, EQ 113. Tests From Which Judges Must Choose.

### AHA Western Horsemanship Medal class.

- In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF Arabian, Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Division, Subchapter Western Horsemanship, AR-26.

### OVERALL HIGH POINT AMATEUR AWARD

This award will be presented to the amateur competitor who accumulates the greatest number of points in classes at the *Summer Sizzler I & II*. Points may be earned in any approved halter class (except futurities) or performance class in which entries are placed. Points are based on a one horse/one rider combination. Any Amateur may sign up as many one horse/one rider combinations as he/she wishes and may ride/handle horses which he/she does not own (in classes other than amateur-owner classes). Any amateur who wishes to compete for this award must sign up in the show office to participate in this high point program. Points do not start to accumulate until participant signs up. Points will be awarded as follows: first=5, second=4, third=3, fourth=2 and fifth=1. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the amateur who accumulates the highest number of points in the smallest number of classes. In the event of a further tie, the award will go to the rider who showed against the largest number of entries.

## DIVISIONS

Photostat copies of your Amateur Certification, USEF Membership Card, AHA Membership Card and registration papers (both sides) for each horse entered **MUST** accompany your entries. Copy of Negative Coggins (6 months) and Health Certificate (30 days) are required for all out-of-state horses.

**EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**

Show management will be charged with the responsibility of enforcing all USEF and AHA Rules. Special emphasis will be placed on the rules pertaining to the retention of natural action; expressly hoof length, weighted shoes or action appliances. The use of chains, rollers, or similar devices on the show grounds during or before a show are prohibited and the Show Committee shall bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the show, and they shall forfeit all entry fees and winnings for the entire show. USEF Rule XVI, Chapter I, Article 1601 regarding use of pads and bar shoes will be strictly enforced.

Show Management retains the right to request measurement of hoofs and inspection of pads of any or all horses in any or all classes.

OVAHA, OVAHA BoD, OVAHA Show Management and/or Champions Center/Clark County Fairgrounds accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to any property or equipment, or for any damages to any animal, spectators or exhibitors at this competition.

**Dress:** It is the tradition of the show ring that riders and drivers be correctly attired for the class in question, THAT ATTENDANTS BE NEATLY DRESSED, and horse properly presented. The Show Committee will bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

**Cancellation of Classes:** The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes or make any scheduling for the betterment of the show.

**Protests:** A protest may be made to Show Committee by an exhibitor, an agent, trainer, or the parent of a Junior Exhibitor for any violation of USEF rules. It must be in writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the Secretary of the Show at which the violation occurred accompanied by a deposit of \$200 for a member (or parent of junior member) and \$300 for a non-member and received by a member of the Show Committee, the Show Manager or the Show Secretary within 48 hours of the alleged violation. This deposit is fully refundable if the protest is upheld.

**Disqualifications:** If any Exhibitor has made any false statements regarding an animal exhibited, or if any Exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from exhibiting. Any action, discourtesy or disobedience to the official on the part of the owner, rider, exhibitor, groom or driver will disqualify the horse from being judged. The Show Management reserves the right to remove any of the previously mentioned (owner, rider, etc.) without being liable to compensation or damages.

**Attention Handler:** Cruelty to or the abuse of a horse by any person at a recognized show is forbidden. Excessive use of the whip on any horse in stall, runway, schooling area, show ring, or elsewhere on the show grounds before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty.

**Stallions:** Stallions may be shown by women and children in all classes except Lead Line and Walk-Trot.

**Junior Exhibitors:** Junior Exhibitor classes are limited to riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, 2010.

**Amateur Classes:** Every person who has reached his 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current amateur certification issued by USEF. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the Show Secretary at least one hour prior to such class an application for such certification provided by USEF. In the event that a person holds an unrevoked certification, but does not have it in his immediate possession, the Show Secretary may accept a signed statement to that effect which must be submitted to the USEF.

**Limit Horse:** This is a horse that has not won six, 1st place ribbons at USEF Regular Member (A, B, and C rated) Competitions. The status of Limit is as of the closing date of entries for any particular recognized competition.

**Calls for Classes:** When the start of any class with no posted order is being delayed by horses not ready to perform, the competition may be closed at the order of the Judge or Show Committee, provided warning is issued and exhibitors are given 3 minutes in which to appear at the in-gate ready to participate. In classes in which horses compete collectively, after warning is issued the In-gate must be closed 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring.

**Parking:** Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse trailers and campers. By Order of the State Fire Marshall, there is no parking in front of or between the barns.

**Admission to Ring:** No persons will be allowed in the ring except participants in class, judge, ringmaster, assistants and show photographer. Attendants will be allowed only after being called by the Judge or Ringmaster.

**Stalling:** All stalls will be reserved as paid for – NO STALL RESERVATIONS WITHOUT PAYMENT. Stalling is in permanent stalls 8 x 10 made from wood and wire fencing with wood sliding doors. Horses may be shown out of trailers. **NO BEDDING IS PROVIDED! Bedding will be available on show grounds.** No nails, staples, or other devices permitted in the permanent stalls. All stalls will be checked for damages and the exhibitor will be charged for such damage to stall(s).

**Refunds:** Refunds on all fees, except for stalls and office fees, will be made upon request with a written statement from a licensed veterinarian if received by July 10, 2011. **No refunds will be made for any reason after July 10, 2011.**

**Food:** Food will be available on the grounds.

**Showers:** Showers are available on the grounds.

**Camper Hook-ups:** Camper hook-ups are available on a first come, first serve basis. Hook-up permits must be displayed in front window of vehicle at all times. The camper fees are paid to the Champion Center.

**Motorized Vehicles:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

**AHA Membership:** Any owner without a current Competition Level AHA Membership must purchase a Single Event Membership for \$35 per person (not per horse). Also, Single Event Memberships are required of all owners, trainers, drivers, riders or halter handlers who do not have current Competition Level Membership.

**Amateur Status:** All riders in ATR classes must have an Amateur Card if over the age of 18. Riders must present this card or make application for one before entering the ring. Applications for amateur cards will be available in the Show Office.

1. The following procedures shall be followed in all breeding classes, including Gelding In-Hand classes:

b. Competition management shall have the option of choosing one of two class procedures:

**(1) - In the Ring Class Procedure**

(2) - Exit the Ring Class Procedure

c. In the Ring Class Procedure

Judging begins when the first horse enters the ring. From the moment the horse enters the ring its movement is being evaluated and scored (2) The horse shall enter at a trot, and at the handler's discretion may either proceed directly along the rail, or trot a counterclockwise circle at the in-gate end of the arena and then proceed along the rail to the far end of the arena. Upon each horse reaching the designated position at the far end of the arena they are to remain relaxed. The judge(s) will then ask for the next horse to enter the ring. When all horses have entered the ring the horses shall be asked to walk collectively counter-clockwise and/or clockwise past each (and all) judge(s). They shall walk in a relaxed manner on a loose lead with the handler at the side of his horse, whips down. The lead line must maintain a discernible drape and the handler must not place his hand on the chain or close enough to in any way restrict the natural head and neck motion. The handler may not unnecessarily impede the forward motion of the horse while at the walk. Following the cessation of the walk all horses shall relax within the ring and only the horse "on deck" shall be prepared to show. Each horse shall be led to the judge(s) at the walk and presented for judging. In order to satisfy a proper presentation to the judge, horses should stand correctly, bearing weight on all four feet (not stretched), in a quiet and deliberate manner. Following the evaluation by the judge(s), horses shall walk away from the judge(s), and then strike a trot before turning left and proceeding counter clockwise down the rail. They shall resume their relaxed position at the end of the arena. The scores for all categories will be completed, recorded, and may be announced at this time.

d. Handlers are expected to keep a reasonable clearance between horses and judges should modify the alignment of horses to achieve that clearance. Further judging will not commence until the Call Judge approves the placement and spacing of all horses.

#### **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in DressageSport Horse Breeding classes.
