Warren County Juvenile Court recently presented its Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP) to the Ohio Supreme Court's Advisory Committee on Courthouse Security and Emergency Preparedness. The Advisory Committee is chaired by Ohio Supreme Court Justice Maureen O'Connor and is charged with making recommendations to the Ohio Supreme Court to improve safety and security in Ohio's courthouses and for continuity operations in the event of an emergency, natural disaster or pandemic. Warren County's COOP includes provision for personnel, information technology and alternate work site in the event of an interruption of regular operations. Warren County's COOP will be considered by the Supreme Court as a model to assist other courts in developing their own COOPs.
